 6. **Community Center Fields Tree Replacement Project:** East side of FFH replacement trees are still being discussed. There are many issues to be considered, ie; function, size, maintenance, pricing and most of all future safety issues as they grow and the age of maturity.
 7. **Tree Ordinance / Borough Tree:** The New Ordinance needs to have further discussions to include new construction, code enforcement and consequence of disregarding the new codes. Reminding the fact that "borough tree" is a nonexistent term eliminated from the ordinance.
 8. **FH Fields Tree Clearing:** There has been ongoing work being done to clear trees and invasives from the field and it is a continual work in progress noted by the STC.
 9. **Accreditation Status for 2019:** As of 8-23-19 STC has successfully fulfilled the accreditation needs once again to be TREE CITY certified. Our Tree City symbols are posted
