BOROUGH OF FAIR HAVEN ORDINANCE NO. 2020-01

2020 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.1 et seq., provides that in preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Fair Haven in the County of Monmouth finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2020 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$67,979.30 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council of the Borough of Fair Haven hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Fair Haven, in the County of Monmouth, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2020 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Fair Haven shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$237,927.55 and that the CY 2020 municipal budget for the Borough of Fair Haven be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years, and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days of such adoption.

BOROUGH OF FAIR HAVEN ORDINANCE NO. 2020-02

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH OF FAIR HAVEN TO ACQUIRE THE PREMISES KNOWN AS 623 RIVER ROAD, BLOCK 25, LOT 10, IN THE BOROUGH OF FAIR HAVEN, MONMOUTH COUNTY, NEW JERSEY, PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:12-1 ET SEQ.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Fair Haven has identified that certain real property designated as Block 25, Lot 10 on the Tax Map of the Borough of Fair Haven, commonly known as 623 River Road in the Borough of Fair Haven (the "Property"), as being appropriate for and needed for a public purpose, to wit, the construction of a municipal building to potentially house the Borough's police department, municipal offices and council chambers; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has negotiated an Agreement for Sale and Purchase of Real Estate to acquire title to the Property listed above with the record title owner of the Property; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has determined that acquisition of the Property, the compensation to be paid for the Property and all matters incidental thereto and arising therefrom will be pursued as provided by <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:12-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Fair Haven has determined that the property is for use of public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the public purpose for said property is for a municipal building.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough of Fair Haven that the Borough of Fair Haven has determined that the property designated as Block 25, Lot 10, on the tax map of the Borough of Fair Haven and commonly known as 623 River Road, in the Borough of Fair Haven, would be an appropriate site for the public purposes of constructing a municipal building to potentially house the Borough's police department, municipal offices and council chambers; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Borough of Fair Haven that the Borough of Fair Haven hereby authorizes the acquisition of the Property designated hereinabove through agreement with the record title owner in accordance with the authority conferred by <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:12-1, *et seq*.; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Borough of Fair Haven that the Borough of Fair Haven is hereby authorized to retain any and all professionals, including but not limited to appraiser(s), professional planners, engineers, environmental consultants and attorneys to effectuate the Borough's acquisition of the Property for the purposes expressed hereinabove.

TITLE:EXPRESS SUPPORT FOR LEGISLATION INCREASING STATE FUNDING TO THE
"SHORE PROTECTION FUND" FROM \$25 MILLION TO \$50 MILLION (A-639/S-1071)

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey maintains the Shore Protection Fund, which was established in 1992; and

WHEREAS, the Shore Protection Fund provides important funding that allows the State and Municipalities to engage in cost-share partnerships with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers on shore protection projects including beach restoration and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Shore Protection Fund is funded by State Realty Transfer Fee revenues, and is currently capped at \$25 million, an amount that was last adjusted in 1999; and

WHERERAS, following the devastating effects of Superstorm Sandy, it has become evident that the current funding to the Shore Protection Fund is inadequate for allowing the State and Municipalities to fund necessary recovery projects; and

WHEREAS, pending before the Legislature are bills A-639 and S-1071, which would increase the cap on funding to the Shore Protection Fund to \$50 million; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council believes this proposed increase to the Shore Protection Fund is essential to protecting the shoreline of the Borough of Fair Haven and that of every other Shore Community compromising the Jersey Shore.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Fair Haven, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that it hereby expresses its support for an increase in funding to the Shore Protection Fund from \$25 million to \$50 million, as provided in the bills pending before the New Jersey Legislature as A-639 and S-1071.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution be transmitted to Governor Phil Murphy, Senate President Steve Sweeney, Assembly Speaker Craig Coughlin, Senator Declan O'Scanlon, Assemblywoman Serena DiMaso and Assemblyman Gerry Scharfenberger.
