BEGINNING MONDAY, DECEMBER 7TH, milling and paving on Battin Road will begin. Residents on Battin Road.....please have your leaves out to the street no later than Sunday, December 6th so DPW can collect the leaves to allow for this road work. There will be a police presence on Battin Road to assist residents with getting in and out of their driveway.

NO OVERNIGHT PARKING on all Borough streets went into effect on November 1st and will remain in effect until April 1st between the hours of 2:00 a.m.- 5:00 a.m. If you need to park a vehicle on the street during these times, please call the non-emergency police number, 732-747-0991, to be put on the overnight parking list for that night. If you need an extended period of time, you will need to fill out a request for extended overnight parking at Police Headquarters, 35 Fisk Street, Monday-Friday 9:30 a.m.- 2:30 p.m. The police will be enforcing this Borough Ordinance so please follow the procedures.
