Dates and Times

Camp is M-F from 8:30-11:30am. Camp will begin June 24 and run through July 26 *Off July 4

Locations & Ages

Camp for children entering grades 1-3 is located at McCarter Park.

Sign in at the playground.

Camp for children entering grades 4-8 is located at Fair Haven Fields.

Sign in takes place next to the playground/concession stand area.

This camp location has previously taken place at Community Center. Due to construction at the Community Center, camp has been moved to Fair Haven Fields for 2024.

Daily Activities

- Campers will participate in many different physical activities throughout the summer. Kickball, soccer, basketball, tag games, playground time, wiffle ball are just a few of the games that are played here on a daily basis.
- One question we have been asked a lot is if we will have basketball at the Fair Haven Fields location– Yes– we will have basketball hoops set up at Fair Haven Fields on one of the tennis courts during camp season.
- In addition to sports, we incorporate an <u>appreciation of the arts</u>. Arts N Crafts are available every day. Other arts related activities include karaoke, Special Craft Days, Poetry Day and more.
- In an effort to <u>connect with our community</u> and community leaders, we host "Meet A Firefighter Day "and well as "Meet A Police Officer Day".
- <u>Each counselor will lead a special activity</u> relating to one of their personal special talents or interests. Anything from singing, dancing, soccer skills, science/history trivia and more!
- <u>Other activities include</u>.... Yoga, Sports Jersey Day, Show And Tell, Talent Shows, Trivia Contests, Spelling Bees, Scavenger Hunts, and more.
- We are big believers in "<u>free play".</u> There is ample time for children to relax & socialize with their friends- new and old.
- Ice Cream Day will be on Tuesdays and Pizza Day will be on Fridays.
- Pizza Days and Ice Cream Days are optional add ons signed up for/paid for *at the time of registration*. You will see this listed as an add on item at the end of your registration.
- **The entire Rec n Crew daily calendar can be found on the Rec website come June.

A currently certified teacher will be the site leader at each of our camp sites. Our other counselors are local high school and college students!

Rain

Unfortunately, since our program takes place outside, rain is certainly an obstacle to overcome.

If heavy rain is predicted or occurs while camp is in session, we may need to cancel camp for the day.

*If it is decided before the camp day begins that camp will need to be canceled, we will send out an email to parents; we try to send this email by 7:30am. Please check your email for any weather related changes.

*If it is decided during the camp day that camp will need to end early due to poor weather, we will send an email and call parents.

Trips

A field trip is a fun way to enhance your child's summer experience. Trips are optional & have an additional cost. Details are available on our Leagueapps page.

Trips must be signed up for online <u>*at the time of registration*.</u> You will see this as an add on option at the end of registration– there will be no exceptions. No refunds will be given if your child cannot attend a trip for which they have registered

for. If you choose not to send your child on a trip, a regular camp day will take place. Children are accompanied by counselors at an 8:1 ratio or better on all trips. Children travel via school bus to and from these trips. **Campers must wear their camp t shirts** while attending trips. Campers going on trips will arrive to camp at the regular start time. Trips may return back to camp after the regular end time. Please see return times listed below.

Costs

The cost for the program is \$200. If you come everyday, that translates to less than \$8.50 per day, or less than \$2.80 per hour.

There is a \$25 Multi Child Discount applied to each child after the first in the same family making registration for subsequent children \$175. This will be automatically discounted at time of purchase. A camp t-shirt will be given to each child during the first week of camp. There is a \$25 late fee if you are not signed up by 5/15
