On October 1, 1967, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued its first set of regulations under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). The regulations, which apply to the disposal of solid wastes, were issued in two parts. Part I, 40 CFR 260-265, established minimum standards for the management of solid wastes generated by industry, mining, construction, agriculture, and other activities. Part II, 40 CFR 270-275, established minimum standards for the management of solid wastes generated by municipal governments. The regulations require generators of solid wastes to identify the wastes they generate and to take steps to ensure that the wastes are managed in a safe and environmentally sound manner. The regulations also require generators to keep records of their waste management activities and to report annually to the EPA.
