

ORDINANCE 6-12-06 (B)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FAIR HAVEN IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE REGULATIONS OF THE BOROUGH OF FAIR HAVEN PERTAINING TO THE REGULAR PICK UP OF BRUSH BY THE FAIR HAVEN DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS MANDATING THAT BRUSH BE PLACED AWAY FROM ALL STORM DRAIN INLETS AS REQUIRED BY THE NEW JERSEY STORMWATER MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS

I.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Chapter 8.28, specifically Section 8.28.040, last revised during the 2002 Codification, to bring the Brush collection requirements in line with the State of New Jersey mandated Stormwater Management regulations. Specifically, this ordinance will require that all brush left for pickup be placed at least ten (10) feet away from all storm drain inlets.

NOTE: Sections of Chapter 8.28 that are to be amended by Ordinance includes only section 8.28.040 Regular pickup of brush and leaves. All additions shown in bold italics with underlines. There are no deletions.

Sections of Chapter 8.28 that will remain unchanged are shown in normal type.

II

Section 8.28.040 Regular pickup of brush and leaves is hereby amended and supplemented to amend subsection A as follows:

8.28.040 Regular pickup of brush and leaves.

The sanitation department shall provide regular pickup of brush and leaves according to a published schedule.

A. Placement of Brush and Leaves. Unless provided otherwise by the Borough Council and published in the collection schedule, brush and leaves shall be placed separately in the street adjacent to the curb and abutting the party's property and shall not be placed closer than 10 feet away from any storm drain inlet. Brush shall be placed no earlier than the Wednesday of the week before, or later than the Wednesday of the week of the scheduled pickup by the borough. Brush and leaves shall not be placed in plastic bags or other types of containers, except for residents on River Road.

B. Grass Clippings, Rakings and Plantings. Grass clippings, rakings and plantings are prohibited from the county landfill and shall not be placed, raked, blown or otherwise caused to be disposed upon the borough streets or curbs. They shall not be picked up by the borough. (Prior code § 3-15.4)
