



**Joint Statement**  
**Borough of Fair Haven – Fair Haven Board of Education**  
**Interlocal Agreement for Improvements to Willow Street**

The Fair Haven Governing Body and the Fair Haven Board of Education are very pleased to announce that we are in the process of finalizing an interlocal agreement that will improve parking, pedestrian safety, traffic flow, and stormwater management, in and around Sickles School and McCarter Park. The agreement equally shares the costs of improvements to both Willow Street and Fair Haven Road including: sidewalks, curbs, school drop-off area, parking stalls, and drainage infrastructure.

The plans for the improvements, which are nearly finalized, have been drafted based on a Sickles School Parking and Traffic Study, the Borough's Active Transportation Plan, and professional design work, all of which utilized the expertise of multiple licensed engineers.

This project is scheduled to take place over the Summer 2021, in conjunction with the final phase of the construction of the new addition at Sickles School. It is anticipated that both projects will be complete in time for Sickles School to open on schedule in September 2021.

In considering the limited space within which we have to work, we believe the proposed improvements at Willow Street to be the best plan possible to improve the area for our community.
