Fair Haven Police Department Traffic Safety Reminders and Updates

Third Street Closure

Residents are reminded that Third Street is closed to thru traffic on school days between 7:30-8:30 and 2:45-3:45. Some vehicles may still be utilizing Third Street but must exit at the closest street. Remind your children that they must always ride their bicycles as near to the right as possible as some vehicles will be present during school closure hours.

Pedestrians (dog walkers, strollers, etc.) are reminded to utilize sidewalks and not walk in the middle of the roadway. This is for your safety.

Vehicles parked on borough streets must be parked facing the right way. Do not drive on the wrong side of the road to park facing the wrong direction.

Do not block fire hydrants.

Do not park on or block sidewalks

Information below regarding Electric Bicycles/Scooters

Low Speed Electric Bicycles:

- 20 mph max speed
- 750 watts or less
- No license, insurance, or registration required
- Must follow all State of NJ laws applicable to bicycles
- Helmet use is required for those under age 17
- No riding or towing passengers
- Parents should closely monitor young children

Low Speed Electric Scooters:

- 19 mph max speed
- No license, insurance, or registration required
- Must follow all State of NJ laws applicable to bicycles
- Helmet use is required for those under age 17
- No riding or towing passengers
- Parents should closely monitor young children
