Dear Fair Haven Residents:

In November of 2020, the Mayor and Council authorized \$332,000.00 in a capital bond ordinance to purchase a new street sweeper. I am very pleased to announce that after a long wait and much anticipation the new machine was delivered to our Department of Public Works Yard earlier today. Our very proficient DPW streets crew have already given it a test run and, as you can see by the video, this major capital investment will greatly improve the cleanliness of our streets. Equally important, is that regular street sweeping conforms to best practices in stormwater management, because it will help improve water quality in the Navesink River by reducing the amount of debris that gets washed into our storm drains. We have some work to do before the sweeper is fully operational; however, you can look forward to seeing the street sweeper in your neighborhood by the summer.
